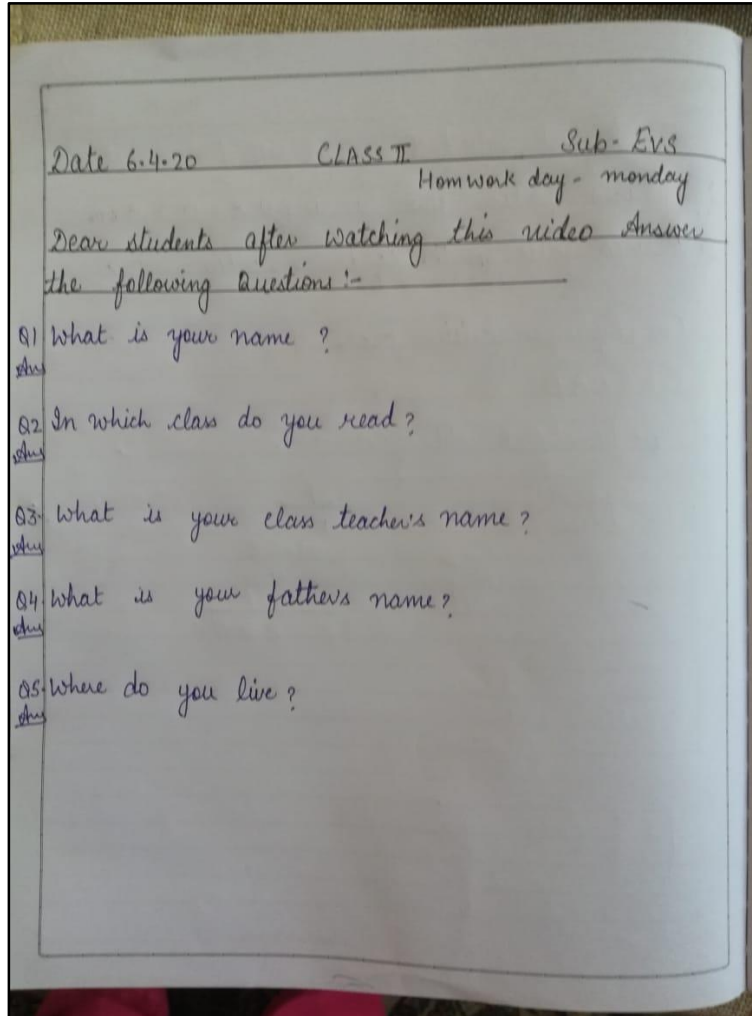

- We use is when we talk about one person or thing.
eg. She is cooking dinner.
He is chopping vegetables.
The dog is playing.

- we use are when we speak about more than one person or thing.
eg. you are going to market.
we are decorating the house.
The birds are flying.

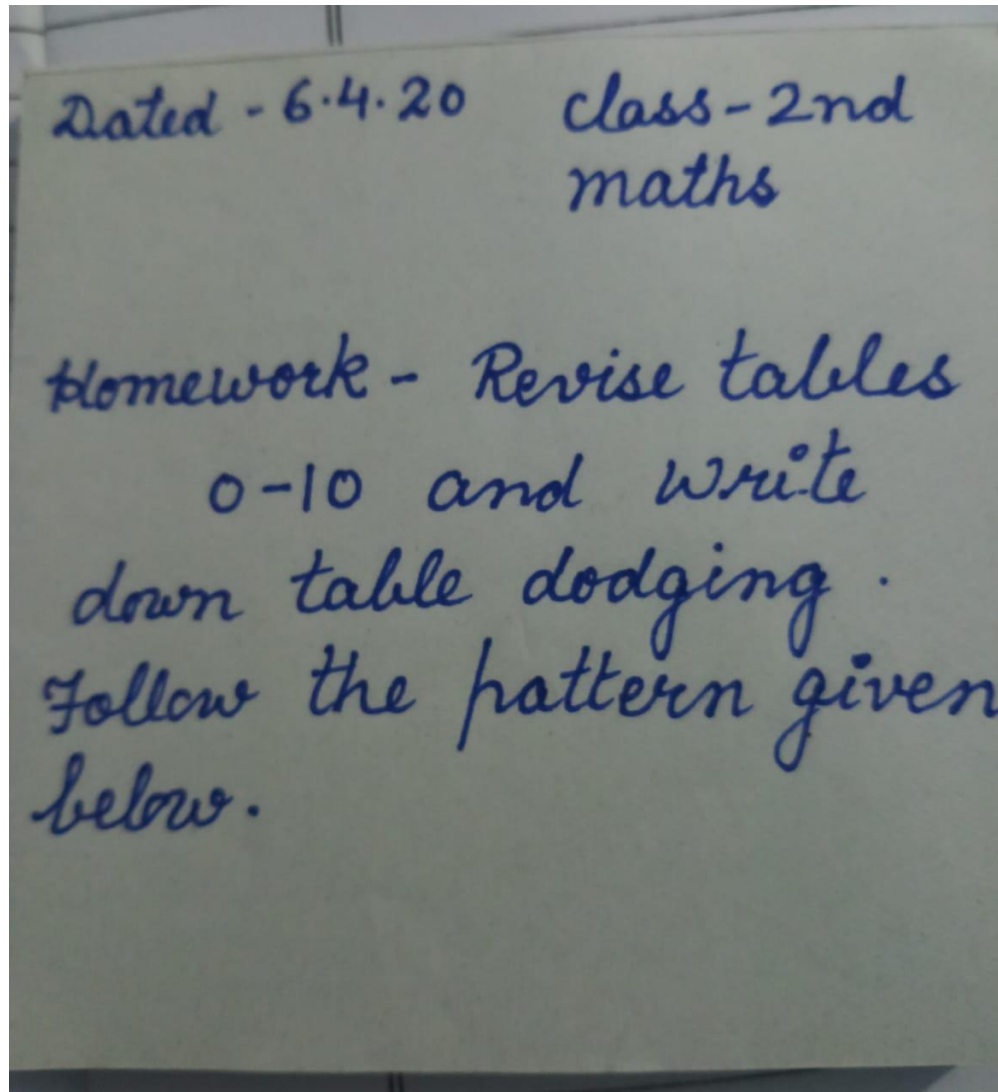
