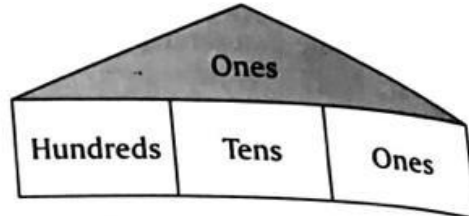
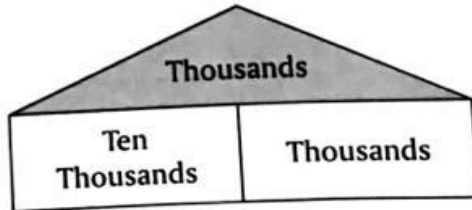
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Reading numbers beyond 999

For reading numbers beyond 999, we use two periods.

- (a) Period of ones – ones, tens, hundreds.
- (b) Period of thousands – thousands, ten thousands.



A comma separates the ones period from the thousands period.

Let us take some examples to understand.

9999 is the largest 4-digit number.









Remember : We do not write 'and' in the number names.
