Pronouns are the words used in place of nouns.

The words I, you, he, she, they, her, us are. They are known as Pronouns.

Types of Pronouns.

1. Personal Pronouns
2. Demonstrative Pronouns
3. Interrogative Pronouns
4. Reflexive Pronouns
5. Intensive (Emphasizing)
6. Possessive Pronouns.

1. Personal Pronouns! - They are.

1. First Person - I, me, we, us
2. Second Person - you, yours
3. Third Person - He, she, they

2. Demonstrative! - This, That, These, Those.

3. Interrogative Pronouns! - who, what, where, whose etc.

4. Reflexive Pronouns! - ends with self or selves

5. Intensive or Emphasising Pronouns: are used with nouns or pronouns. eg. myself, yourself, herself etc.

6. Possessive Pronouns: show ownership.

Possessive Pronouns are. mine, his, their, ours, yours etc.
